SEM Committee Decision for the Regulatory Authorities in relation to Mod_06_20 (Final Recommendation FRR_06_20)

Dear Esther,

On 8 March 2021, the Modifications Committee submitted its Final Recommendation Report (FRR) with regard to Modification Proposal Mod_06_20 'Removing the Requirement for a Monthly Load Forecast' in accordance with Paragraph B.17.18.1 of Part B of the SEM Trading and Settlement Code (TSC). The Modification Proposal Mod_06_20 was submitted to the Modifications Committee by EirGrid on 9 April 2020 and following a number of discussions was voted on at Meeting 103 on 11 February 2021.

The Regulatory Authorities understand that this Modification removes the requirement for the TSOs to provide a monthly load forecast as it has limited use for Market or TSO processes of for market participants. Annual and Four Day Load Forecast will continue to be published on the SEMO website. The Regulatory Authorities note that the impact of removing this report was discussed at a number of Modifications Committee Meetings and nine Members of the Modifications Committee voted to approve the Modification.

Considering the above, and in accordance with Paragraph B.17.20 of the Code, the SEM Committee direct that a Modification, as set out in Appendix 1 of FRR_06_20, is implemented on a Settlement Day basis with effect from one Working Day after this letter is issued.
