Agreed Procedure Notification

Mod_14_22 Removal of the requirement to post De-registration Consent Orders

MODIFICATIONS COMMITTEE MEETING 113 MINUTES

Proposer SEMO

The Proposer went through the Modification Proposal noting that there would be a minor change to Agreed Procedure 18 in relation to the process of issuing de-registration documentation to stakeholders. It was advised that the added requirement of issuing documents by Registered Post was unnecessary and by removing it, it would reduce paperwork.

A Supplier Member understood the rational above and but noted that registered post provides the trackability needed in these circumstances. It was suggested that a confirmation of receipt could be added for further assurance of delivery and the Proposer agreed to this. An agreement was made that this extra step would be added into the AP Notification.

2 NOTIFICATION

As per Section B.17.21.2 of the T&SC, the Modifications Committee wishes to notify the RAs of the effective date for Mod_14_22 Removal of the requirement to post De-registration Consent Orders to be the third Working Day following publication of AP notifications unless a veto is received from the Regulatory Authority. This Notification was published on 23rd November 2022.



3 LEGAL DRAFTING

As set out in the legal drafting section of <u>Mod_14_22 Removal of the requirement to post De-registration Consent Orders</u> with the agreed legal drafting changes below:

The below amendments are proposed to Agreed Procedure 18 -

2.1 Once a decision has been made, the Market Operator shall notify the Participant by registered post acknowledged email issuing a Deregistration Consent Order. The Market Operator will request confirmation of receipt from participants when the Deregistration Consent Order is issued,

3.1.8 Send Deregistration Consent Order to Participant, System Operators, Relevant Meter Operator, and Regulatory Authorities. Before Deregistration date <u>Email Registered Post</u>
